Care Workers - Children's Services

Adelaide Metropolitan Region
South Australian Country Regions

The Foundation is seeking care workers to provide care, guidance and support to children and young people under Guardianship of the Chief Executive, Department for Child Protection (DCP).

Care workers help deliver residential care services, working with DCP to achieve positive outcomes for children and young people.

Working across a flexible roster, shifts are typically 8 hours and may include active (awake) and passive (sleeping) overnight shifts. Care workers receive comprehensive induction and training, and access to a Staff Benefits Program.

The Foundation is seeking people with relevant work or study placement experience working with children and young people in an educational or care setting; caring and responsible people who enjoy working as part of a team and can meet specific requirements (see overleaf).

If you want to help make a positive difference in the lives of children and young people, we want to hear from you.

Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander applicants are encouraged to apply.

Role Requirements

1. Complete or enrolled to complete minimum qualifications in any of the following:

- **Certificate IV in Child, Youth and Family Intervention**
- **Certificate IV in Community Services**
- **Certificate IV in Youth Work**
- **Certificate IV in Disability** (subject to nominated electives)

2. Complete or enrolled to complete minimum training in all of the following:

- HLTAID004 Provide an Emergency First Aid Response in an Education and Care Setting Certificate (within the past 3 years)
- HLTAID001 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Certificate (issued within the past 12 months)
- Safe Environments for Children and Young People 'Through their Eyes' Certificate (issued within the past 3 years)

3. Hold, or be willing to obtain all of the following:

- Current Full Class C South Australian Driver's Licence
- Current Private Vehicle with Roadworthiness Report
- Current Motor Vehicle Registration
- Current Motor Vehicle Insurance (third party property insurance or comprehensive car insurance)
- Current Working with Children Check (issued within past 5 years); or former DHS Child-Related Employment Clearance (issued within past 3 years)
- Right to live and work in Australia
