NEW Understanding Support at Home

With the Support at Home program being introduced in July this year, we will continue to provide updates as we receive information. As a reminder, if you currently have a Home Care Package, you will transition to the Support at Home program on 1 July 2025, with unspent funds carrying over. The "no worse off" principle principle also applies to your out-of-pocket contribution arrangements, if, as of 12 September 2024, you were receiving a package, on the National Priority System, or assessed as eligible for a package.

If you haven't received your shingles vaccine yet, we encourage you to speak with your GP or pharmacist about how to access it. Staying up to date with vaccinations is an essential part of maintaining your health.

The flu can be more serious for older adults, so it's a great time to talk to your GP about getting your free annual flu vaccination, available through the National Immunisation Program.
